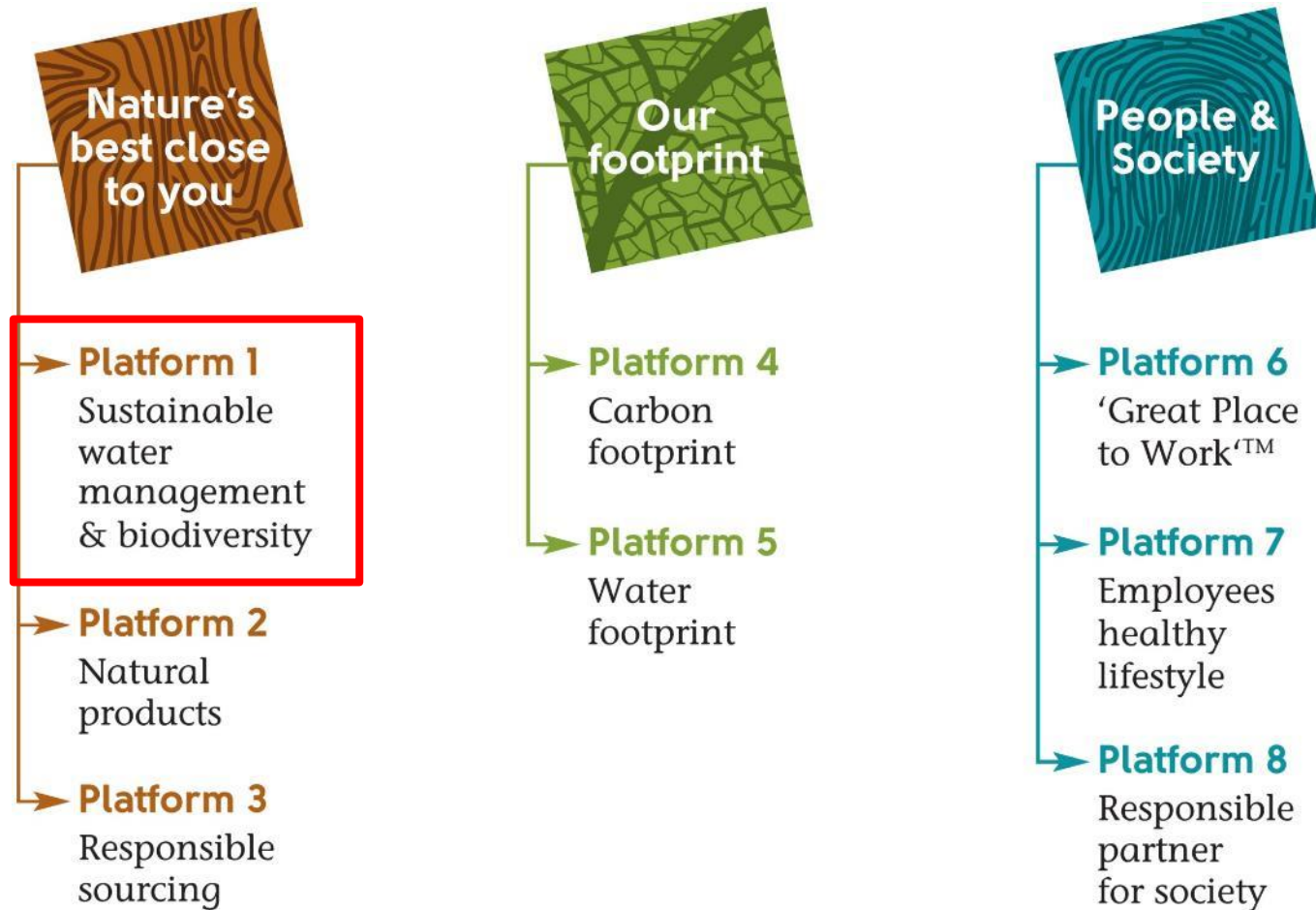

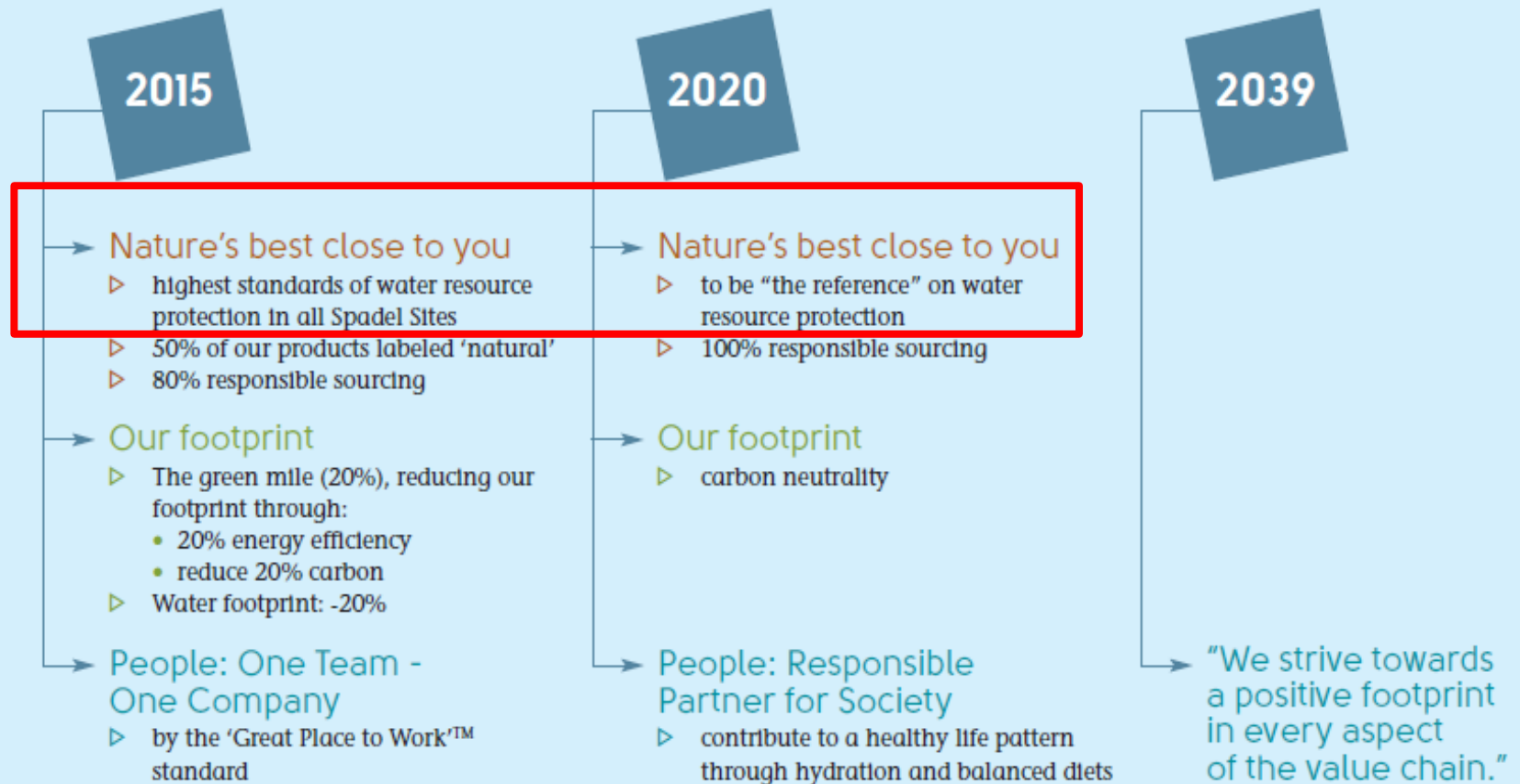

Partenariat privé-public Spa Monopole - Région wallonne - Ville de Spa - Domaine Spa Berinzenne.

Objectifs (dans le bassin d'alimentation)

- Maintien et préservation des zones humides (Fagnes)
- Respect de la biodiversité: résineux-feuillus, plantes, ...
- Interdiction des pesticides, engrais, amendements.
- Obligation d'utilisation huiles biodégradables pour les outils et engins forestiers.
- Interdiction des sels de déneigement.
- Imperméabilisation des zones de parking avec déshuileur...
